


Step One: Logging into Gmail and Autodesk

- Log into your VHP email address through Gmail (www.gmail.com). Please enter the email address and the password provided to you by the Victoria Hand Project.

- Once you are logged in you should see an unread message from Autodesk with the Subject Line **[Confirmation + Next Step]**. Click on this email to open it.

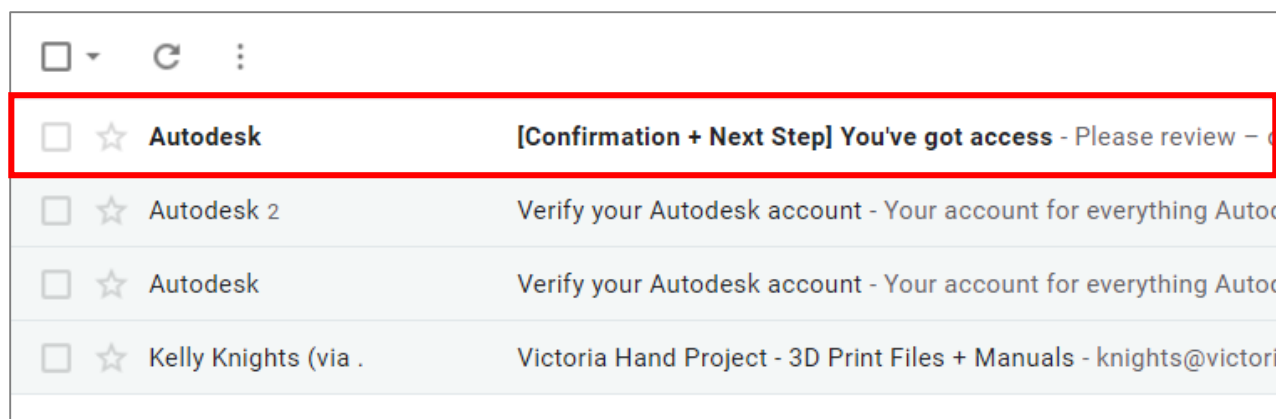


Figure 2: Open the unread email from Autodesk titled [Confirmation + Next Step]

- The email should look something like this:

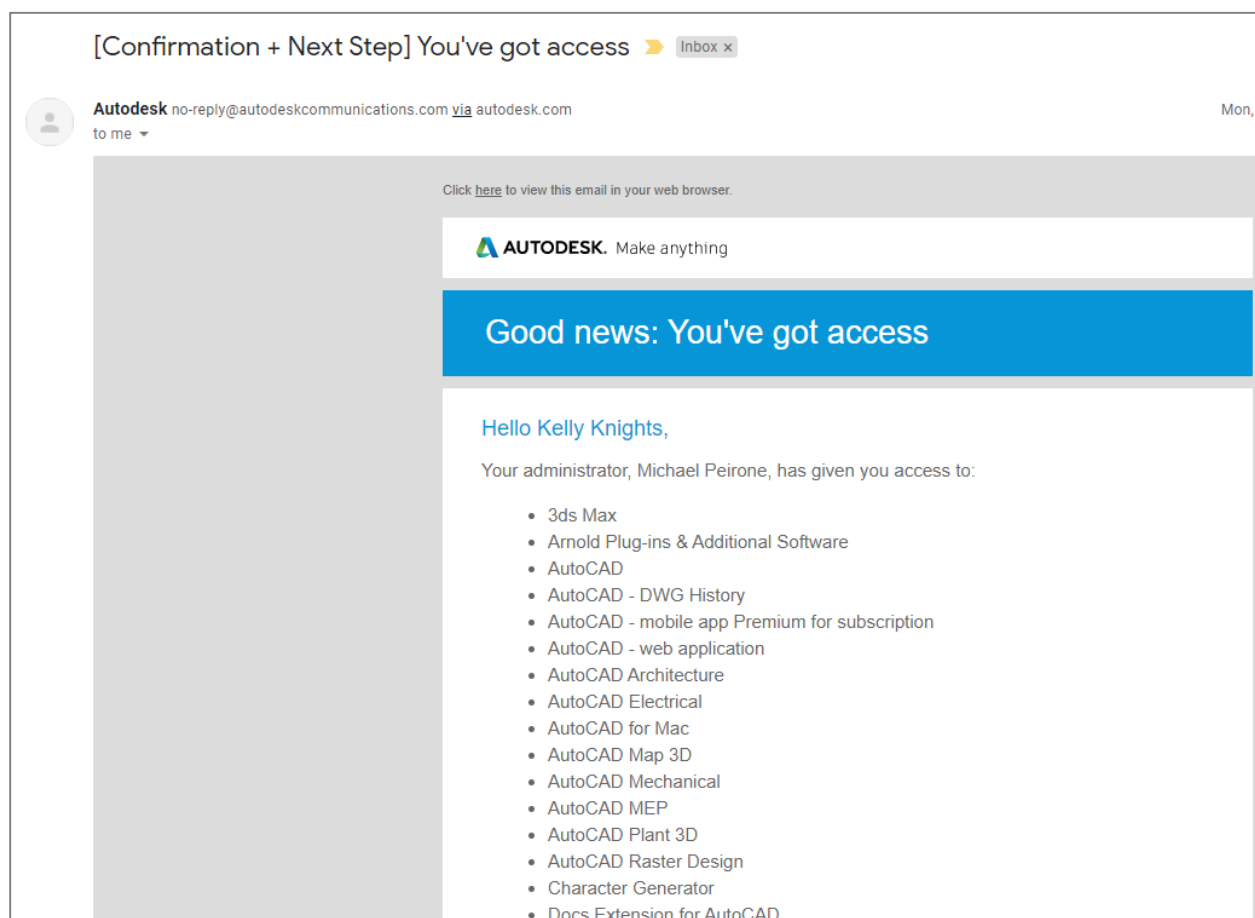


Figure 3: Autodesk Email

- Scroll to the bottom of the email and click the button that says '**SIGN IN TO GET STARTED**'.

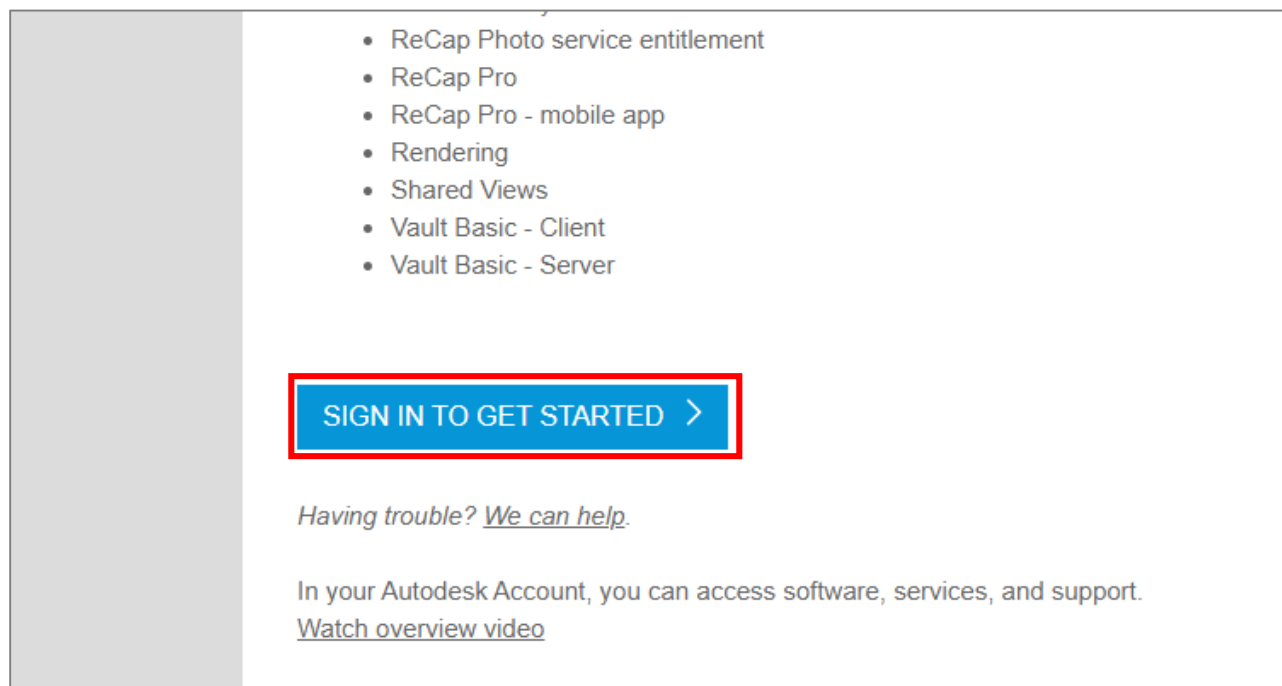


Figure 4: Scroll to the bottom of the Autodesk email and click Sign in to Get Started

- A webpage will open up asking for an email. Please type in the same Victoria Hand Project email that you used to sign into the Gmail with.




Step Two: Downloading Fusion 360

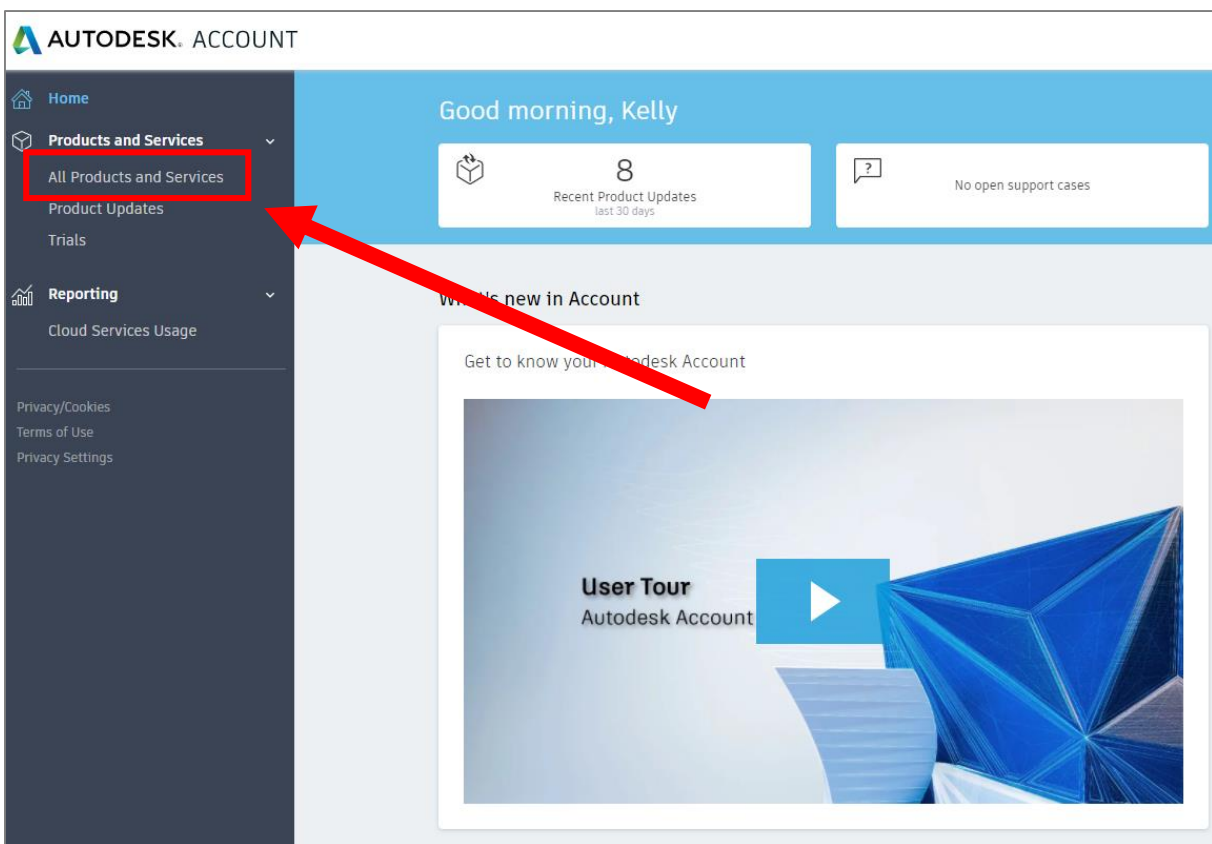


Figure 7: Autodesk Screenshot

- Once you are logged in, the webpage should look similar to Figure 7 below. Click '**All Products and Services**' on the left-hand side of the screen.

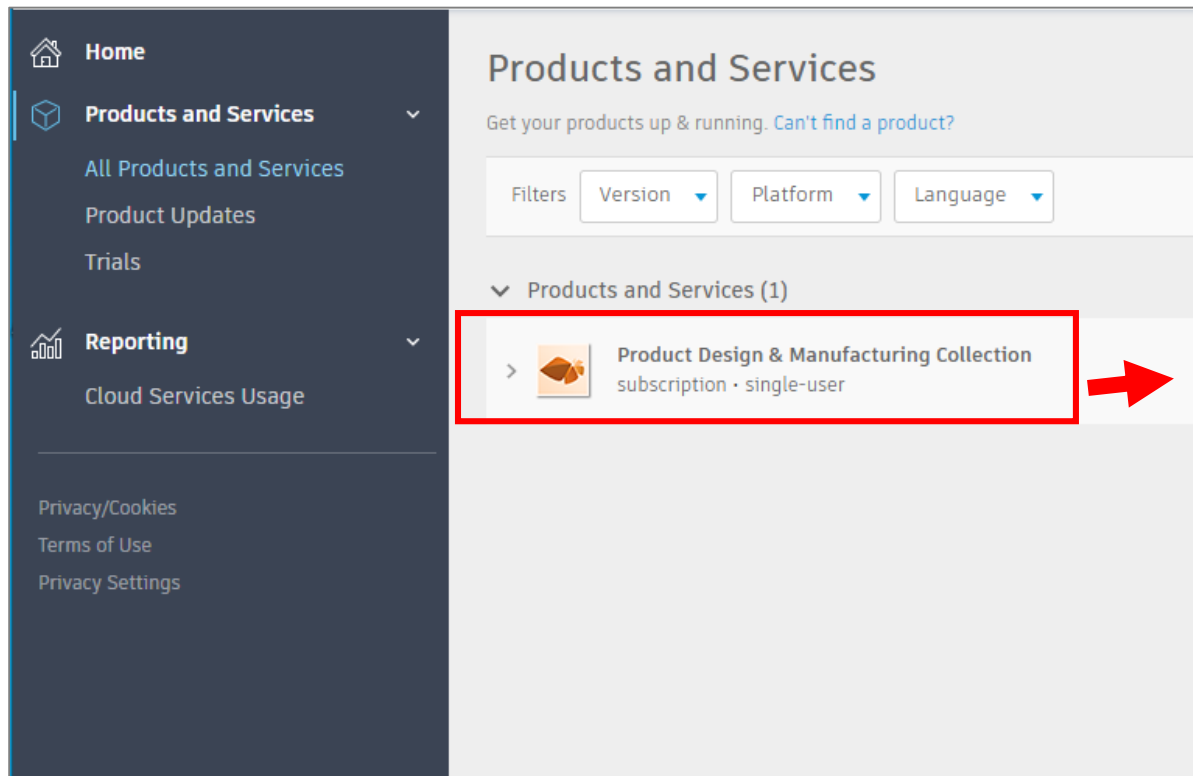


Figure 8: Autodesk Screenshot #2

- Once you have clicked on '**All Products and Services**', the webpage should display something similar to Figure 8 below. To the right of '**Product Design & Manufacturing Collection**', click '**View Items**'

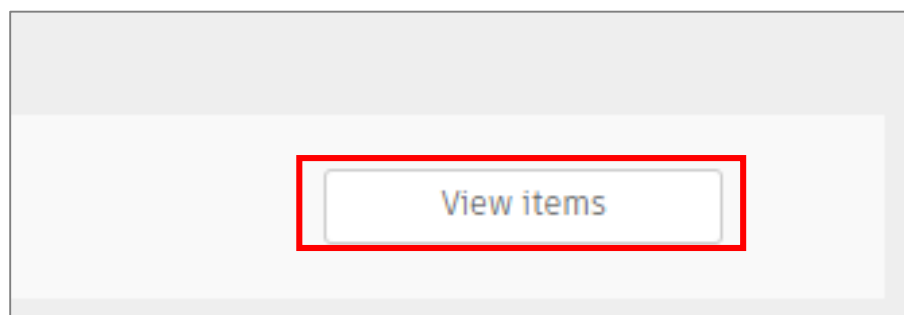


Figure 9: Click on this button in Autodesk Screenshot #2

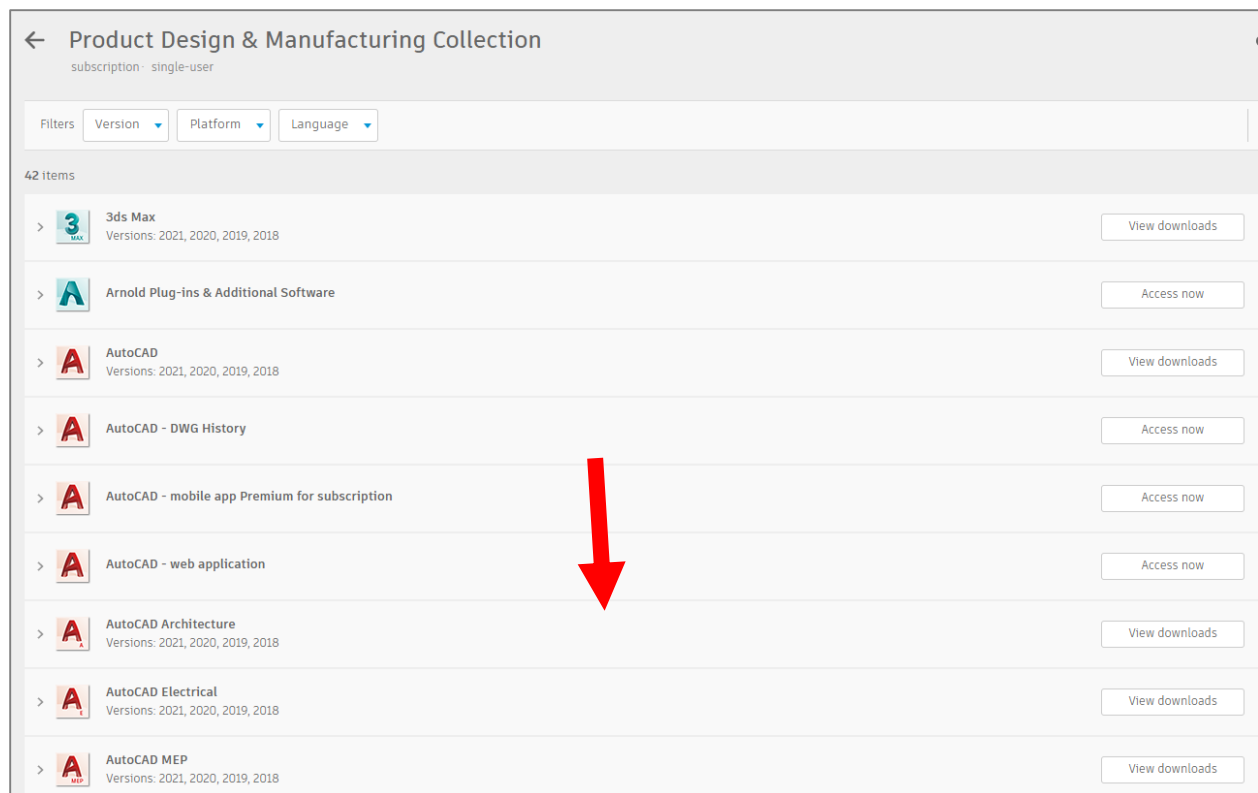


Figure 10: Autodesk Screenshot #3

- Once you have clicked on '**View items**' the webpage should look similar to Figure 10 below.

- Scroll down until you see 'Fusion 360'

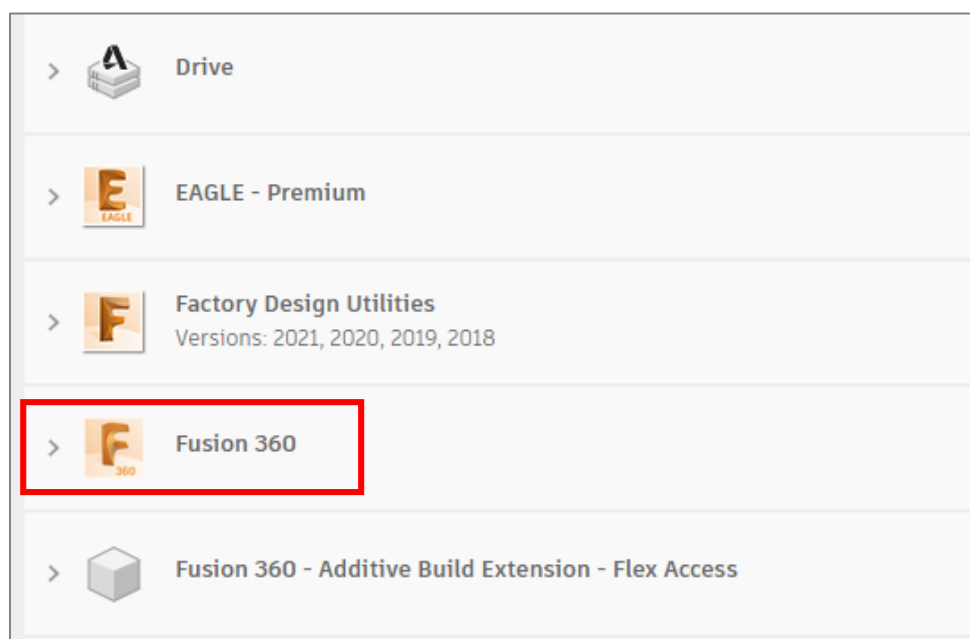


Figure 11: Look for Fusion 360

- To the right of Fusion 360, click '**Download Now**'.

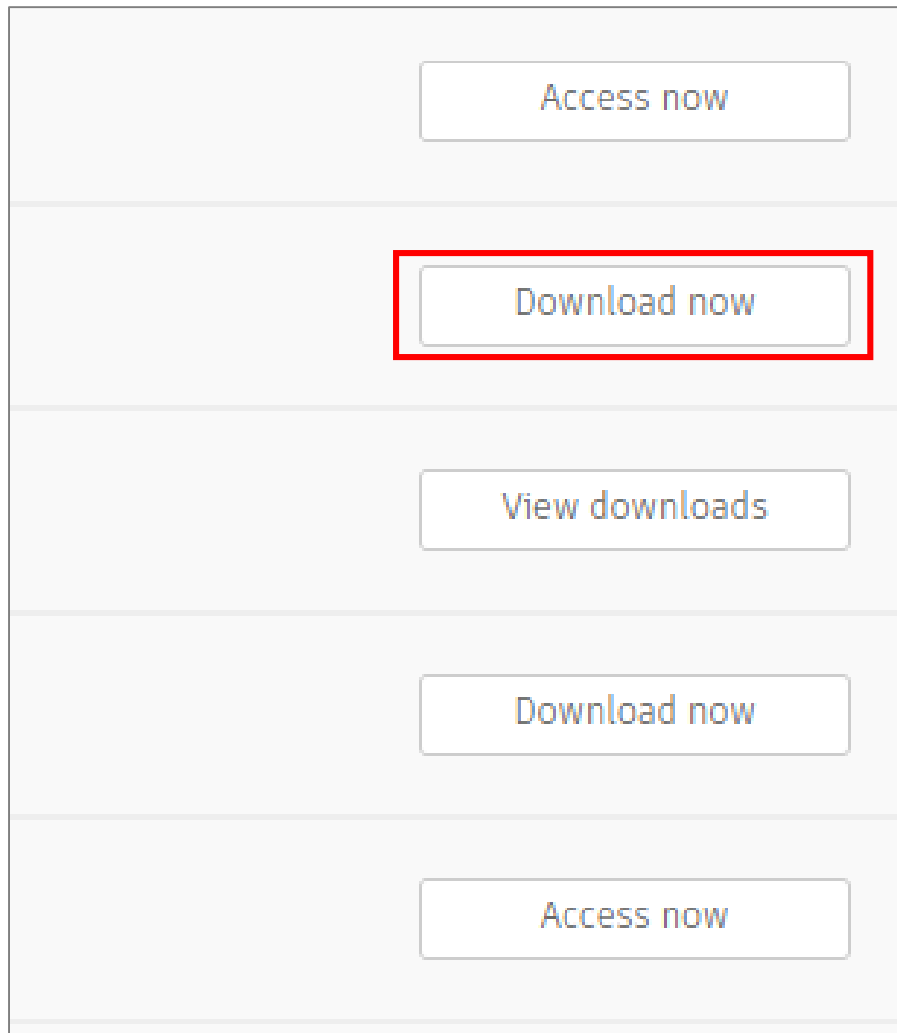


Figure 12: Click 'Download Now' beside the Fusion 360 icon in the list

- The Fusion 360 .exe file should begin to download immediately.

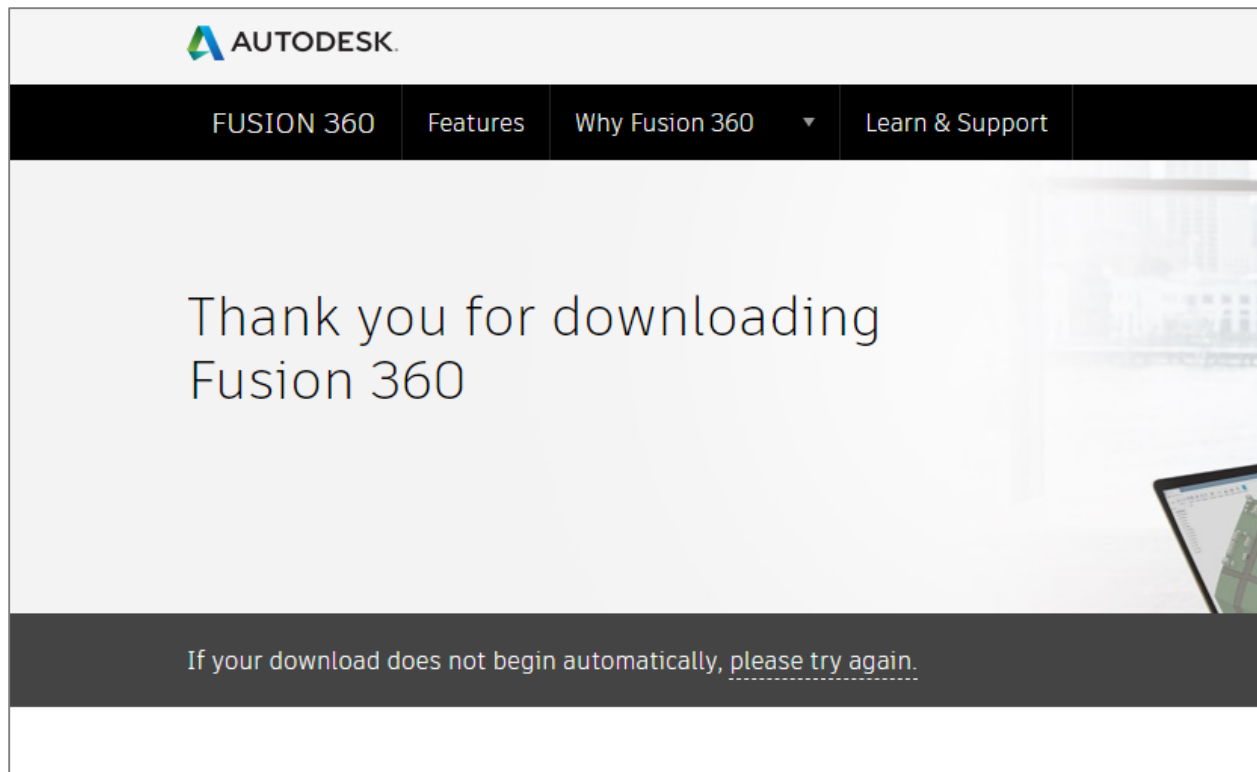


Figure 13: You will be brought to this page

Step Three: Installing Fusion 360

- Double click the Fusion 360 Client .exe file to begin the download

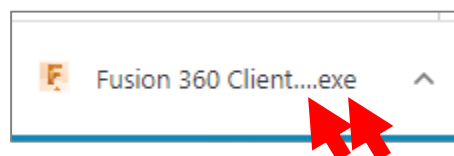


Figure 14: Run the .exe file

- Fusion 360 will begin installing on your computer. You can do other things while this installs in the background.



Figure 15: Download window at 0%

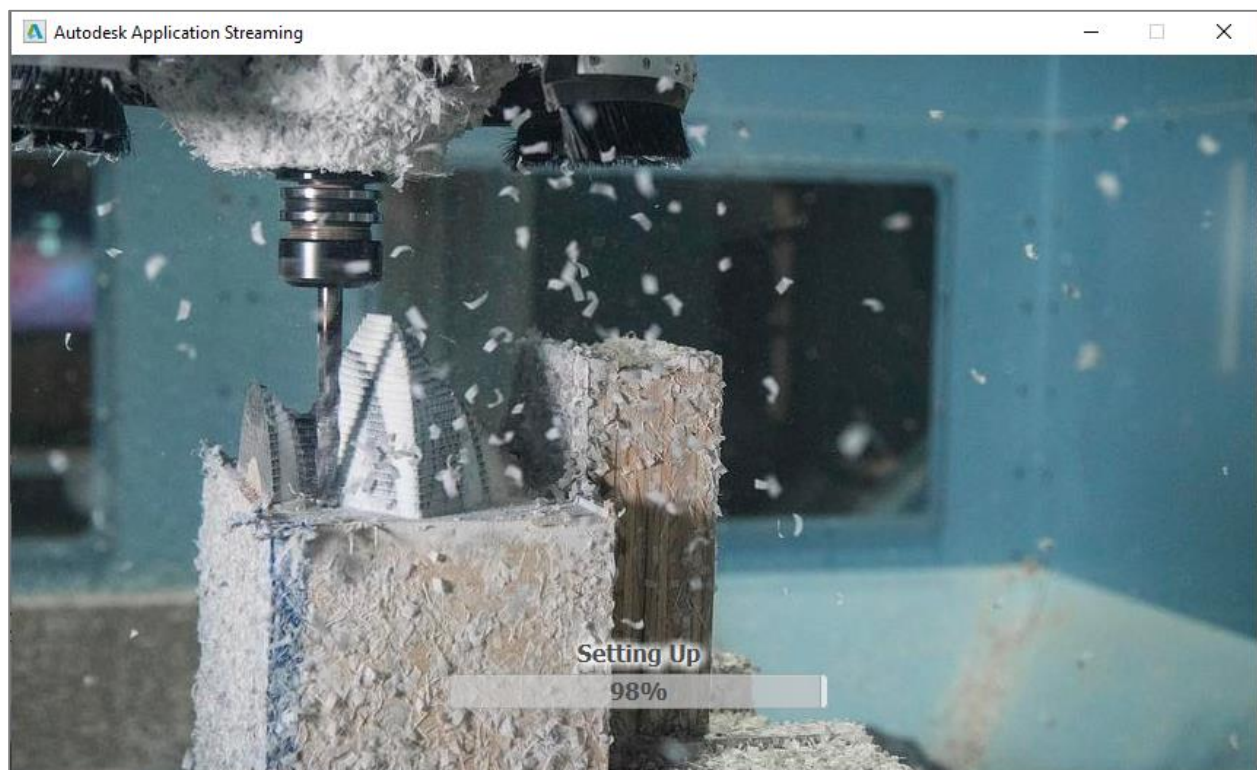


Figure 16: Download window at 98%

- Once Fusion 360 is done installing, it will open automatically and prompt for one more log-in. Please enter your Victoria Hand Project provided email address and password.


